Study Active Certificate (SAC) criteria

- The certificate must not become a motivation to take place in a committee or board; hence the high requirement of 2 active years.
- The certificate bears the name of Pharmaciae Sacrum and of the faculty. The certificate is signed by the praeses of G.F.S.V. "Pharmaciae Sacrum" and the Program Directors of the bachelor and master Pharmacy.
- The committees/boards must have affinity with the study. The University Council is the only exception to this.
- It goes for all committees that committee members are awarded points for the same committee during a maximum of 2 years.
- At least 14 points must be obtained from boards/committees or you must have taken place in at least three boards/committees. Symposia include the Dies Symposium (2 points), the SSS Symposia (1 point), and the symposium of the K.N.P.S.V. during the Congress (2 points). Visits to symposia are tracked by the board or the organizing committee by means of having attendance lists signed before and after the symposium. The organizing committee receives no points for attending an activity that was organized by themselves. The same goes for the board; board members also do not receive points for the activities that they attend during their board year. Participation in the SEP counts for 4 points below the number of symposia. Attendances of the KNMP congresses cannot be monitored and therefore do not count.
- Activities such as the National Business Trip (BBB), the Foreign Trip and the TWIN do not award SAC points. The Support Committees (HC's) of the Introduction, Dies, Congress, and Lustrum Committee do not count either.
- Board members do not receive points for being part of committees of P.S. or the K.N.P.S.V. in their board year, because this is part of their duties.
- Points for the Career Day Committee, the Charity, Entertainment and Sports Committee, the Sports Committee of the K.N.P.S.V. and the Future, Career and Perspective Committee are granted retroactively.
- You must apply for the SAC yourself at P.S. by indicating that you want to receive a SAC. It must be stated here in which committees/boards you have been part of and (optionally) when. If you were part of a committee/board at an organization other than P.S., documentary evidence (e.g. student assistant payslips) must also be submitted. The board calculates the number of points for you. If the number of points is sufficient, a SAC will be awarded.
- An appendix will be added to the SAC stating which committees/boards have been joined. The total number of points and functions are not mentioned on the certificate. You can choose to apply for your SAC if you have 25 points, or if you want you can wait until you graduate.
- In some individual cases it will be possible to discuss the number of points. For example if a committee is not on the list, or if in your case more points should be awarded for that committee. The board has the final say in this.
